### **Appointment process**

- Appointments are for a period of three years and re-appointment can be made by the examinations committee and depending on the requirements of the Examination at the time. Under normal circumstances, examiners will be appointed for a maximum of twelve years
- In making appointments the examinations committee may seek advice from other sources about the suitability of applicants.
- New examiners are normally appointed subject to observation at one fellowship examination, attendance at an examiners' workshop if no previous experience as an examiner, a probationary period of one year.

### **Annual contribution of examiners**

- All examiners are expected to participate in examination preparation processes (including preparing and marking written questions, submission of multiple choice questions and preparation of OSCE/vica voce scenarios) throughout the year, as well as attend at least one examination every two years year and one long case assessment every year. They are also required to assess at least one clinical case study per year.
