Trainees must complete two long case assessments with at least one being completed during the practice development stage.

Eligibility for the Long Case Assessment

Applicants must be a trainee with the Faculty of Pain Medicine and must apply, nominate a preferred examination venue and submit this form with payment of the application fee by the closing date. To be eligible to sit a long case assessment, trainees must have completed at least one satisfactory ITA and the general physical examination assessment.

Closing date for the March/April 2019 long case assessment sitting: **February 22, 2019.**

Candidates with a chronic illness or disability who wish to apply for a special consideration must submit fully documented application to the chair, Examination Committee at least four weeks prior to the published closing date.
