We are currently hiring for a permanent Consultant for our Chronic Pain Service. The Chronic Pain Service is part of the CMH's Department of Anaesthesia and Pain Medicine. It aims to provide quality chronic pain assessment and intervention that is accessible and appropriate for the people of Counties Manukau.

The Counties Manukau Chronic Pain Service includes specialist clinicians from medical (anesthetic, musculoskeletal medicine, psychiatry), nursing, allied health (physiotherapy) and psychological medicine (psychology, psychiatry) backgrounds working within an interdisciplinary model. We work with patients and whanau within a biopsychosocial framework, providing initial triple discipline assessments, individual specific treatments, and several group programmes.

We are a friendly, supportive and passionate team, who also provide regular teaching and further training opportunities. The service is primarily based at the Manukau Super Clinic, with some regular clinics in Pukekohe and Botany.

It is expected that the successful applicant will have had some training and experience in complex or chronic pain management, preferably within a multidisciplinary setting. In addition, knowledge of current pharmacological approaches to pain management, familiarity with active and non-pharmacological approaches, and some experience with pain management programs, would be an advantage.

You will have a dedicated consultant to take you through the recruitment process including registration and on boarding ensuring a comfortable transition.
