Canterbury District Health Board (CDHB) is home to an innovative Pain Management Centre at Burwood Hospital working with people who have chronic non-malignant pain, and frequently an array of other factors affecting their well being. The Pain Management Centre works as an interdisciplinary team to help patients reclaim areas of function in their lives that have been lost as a result of chronic pain. The co-ordinated interdisciplinary service provides outpatient clinics and programmes; interventional procedures and occasional inpatient admissions. This service is one of only three training units in New Zealand recognised by the Faculty of Pain Medicine for the training in Pain Medicine towards fellowship of the Faculty of Pain Medicine.
